

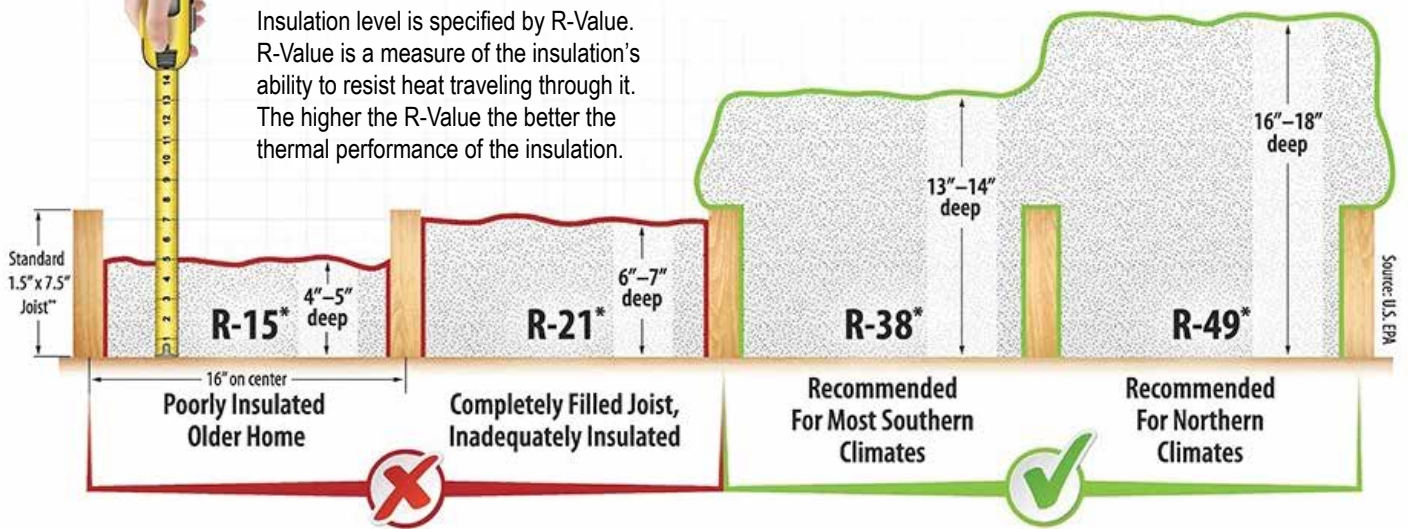


# Attic Insulation

What does it accomplish?

## What is the R-Value of attic insulation in your home?

Insulation level is specified by R-Value. R-Value is a measure of the insulation's ability to resist heat traveling through it. The higher the R-Value the better the thermal performance of the insulation.



\* Recommended Dept. of Energy attic insulation levels for commonly used fiberglass, mineral wool, and cellulose insulation assuming about R-3 per inch.

\*\* Standard joists are sold as 2" x 8" but usually measure closer to 1.5" x 7.5."
